



CRITERIA TO BECOME A MAIN TRAINER WITH THE RCNI

- Must be a registered and accredited counsellor with the RCNI
- Must be working with an RCC
- Must have three years' work in a RCC, having completed the RCNI training/Granny clause
- Must have 1000 supervised client hours
- Must have undertaken at least 100 hours personal therapy and remain open and committed to both further personal work and training
- Must have adequate group facilitation skills/experience and training (VEC level one)
- Other training/experience preferable

CRITERIA TO BECOME A CO-TRAINER WITH THE RCNI

- Must be a registered and accredited counsellor with the RCNI
- Must have three years' work in a RCC, having completed the RCNI training/Granny clause OR if a Co-Trainer for the SATU training
- Must have 500 supervised client hours
- Must have undertaken at least 50 hours personal therapy and remain open and committed to both further personal work and training
- Must have an understanding and awareness of group process and a commitment to undertaking group facilitation skills
- Other training/experience preferably
